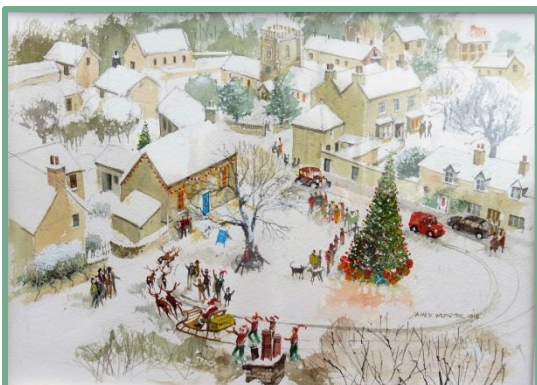
LIBRARY PLOUGHMAN'S LUNCH
